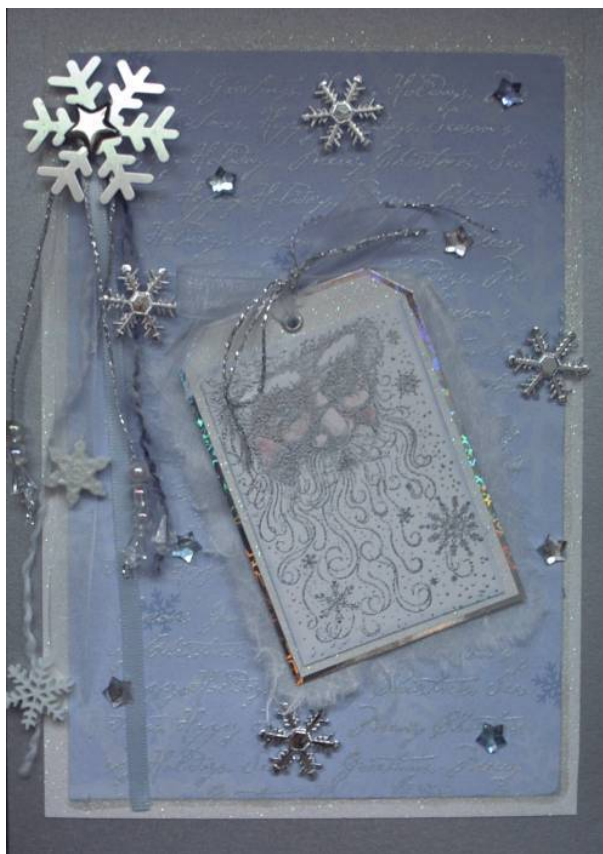


Frosty Santa



The stamps I used to create this card are as follows :

Also Required

- A silver A5 sized card
- A sheet of Paper Adventures Snowflake background paper (Gallery Series 6 by Michelle Ackerman)
- Some scraps of silver thread, ribbons and yarns
- A small piece of silver crafter's cord
- Some beads and pearls
- A 'Making Memories' snowflake eyelet charm
- A silver star brad
- Silver snowflake shapes or confetti
- A sheet of white glitter card
- A scrap of silver holographic or silver mirri card
- Some decorating chalks
- A piece of white mulberry paper
- White pigment embossing inkpad
- Silver pigment embossing inkpad (I used the Encore Ultimate Metallic one)
- White satin pearl embossing powder
- Silver detail & stardust embossing powder mixed (for Santa's face)
- A couple of white and silver snowflake buttons (or confetti)
- Blue and clear 'Crafty Bits' stars
- Double sided tape / Xyron
- Silicone glue

Method

- Cut a piece of white glitter paper approx 13cm wide x 19.5cm tall. To reduce the weight on the front of the card itself, I cut out the centre piece approximately 2cm from the edge. This left me with a glitter 'frame'. Use double sided tape or a Xyron to mat the glitter frame onto the front of the card.
- Cut a piece of the snowflake baking paper approx 12cm wide x 18cm tall. Stamp the Rubber Stampede 3421R - Sayings Background in white and emboss with the white satin pearl powder. Mount the snowflake paper on top of the glitter frame using double sided tape.
- Gather together your scraps of thread and ribbon, and attach to the top left hand side of the card using silicone glue. Embellish each 'dangly bit' with some beads or a button.
- Use the snowflake eyelet charm to cover the ends of the threads. I put the brad through the centre hole to avoid the silicone glue from showing through.
- Stamp the Rubber Stampede 3408F Santa Collage onto a piece of card with the silver inkpad. To match the style of the card, I mixed up some stardust and silver detail embossing powders.
- Colour Santa's face using chalks, and also gently 'edge' the card in pale blue. Create a 'mat' for the stamp using white glitter card and a piece of silver card. Cut around the stamp to create a tag shape.
- Either use a hole punch and a silver eyelet peel-off or set an eyelet onto the tag. Mount onto a piece of hand-made paper. (To achieve the 'fluffy' look, gently wet the edge of the paper and pull the strands).
- Attach the entire tag onto the front of the card, and embellish with additional threads / ribbon.
- Attach the snowflakes and Crafty Bits embellishments onto the front of the card wherever you choose.
