

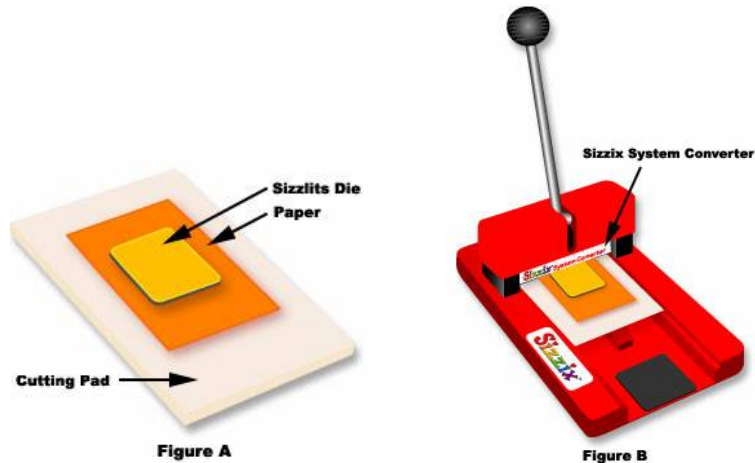
# Sizzix™ Instructions

It is possible to cut both Sizzlits and other manufacturer's low profile (for example QuickKutz) dies using your large Sizzix machine.

## To cut Sizzlits

You need to purchase an extra piece of equipment called a Sizzix™ System Converter. This is a black magnetic plate which you place underneath the pressing platform, under the handle.

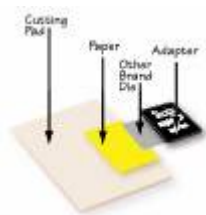
1. First, put the system converter under the pressing platform.
  2. Put your paper onto the white Sizzix cutting mat.
  3. Put the Sizzlits die on top of the paper.
  4. Lower the handle.
- If you find that your die is not cutting properly, you may be trying to cut card that is too thick. You should not attempt cut paper thicker than 100gsm using Sizzlits in your Sizzix machine. Sizzlits have been designed to cut just paper, not card.
  - If your white cutting mat is very well used, try cutting the Sizzlit die in a different place on the cutting mat (for example at the edge rather than the middle). You can also add a shim (a piece of normal copier paper folded in half) under the cutting mat to raise it up a little.



## To Cut QuickKutz Dies

As well as the Sizzix System Converter, you also need another piece of equipment called a Sizzix Adapter. This is a small black piece of plastic which is the same size and shape as a Sizzlit die.

1. First, put the system converter under the pressing plate.
2. Put the paper onto the white Sizzix cutting mat.
3. Put the QK die on top of the paper foam side down.
4. Put the Sizzix Adapter instruction side down on top of the QK die.
5. Lower the handle.



- If you are having trouble getting a clean cut using your QK dies, you can remove the foam from the back. This can help give you a cleaner cut.
- Also remember that you should only attempt to cut paper 100gsm or below, not card.
- If your white cutting mat is very well used, try cutting the die in a different place on the cutting mat (for example at the edge rather than the middle). You can also add a shim (a piece of normal copier paper folded in half) under the cutting mat to raise it up a little.
